

We had over 14,500 visitors come through the gates! That was a substantial increase from the previous couple of years (post-covid). Wow! We are so appreciative of all the volunteers for your time, talent, and everything you did to make it a successful event. Thank you!

We opened the new barn/museum and exhibits for Lilac Days 2023. We received many compliments, and the history and displays were spectacular! The timeline with all the photos told the story of Hulda and her family and the journey through time, beginning from the trek from Germany on the ship to the end of Hulda's life, and then how the Hulda Klager Lilac Society was formed and all those that saved the beloved gardens.

Plant sales, gift shop and raffle sales were all great too. Speaking of plants, we sold over 13 varieties of 2" tissue cultures and 25 varieties of 1-to-2-gallon lilac plants which was over 4,000 plants. Hulda's Birthday, History and Tidbits.

I like to look at historical information and here's a few things I'd like to share. Hulda W. Thiel Klager was born on May 10, 1863, in Germany, died March 19, 1960, at age 96. She and her husband Frank Klager are buried at the Odd Fellows (I.O.O.F.) cemetery in Woodland, WA. Hulda was the daughter of Gottfried Thiel and Wilhelmina Thiel, wife of Frank Klager, mother of Elizabeth Mills, Idelia Guild Wilke, Martha, and Fred "Fritz" Klager. Also, siblings: brothers Auguste Thiel, Julius Thiel and Emil Thiel; sisters Emilie Auguste Strong and Bertha Thiel Tesch.

We celebrated Hulda's birthday at Lilac Days in remembrance of the "Lilac Lady" and her passion for lilacs, cultivating them and sharing them with family, friends, and neighbors.

How to care for lilacs

- by Ruth Wendt, June 2023

- 1. Cut with knife or pruning shears.
 Cut 2" off stems or branches to enhance water uptake.
- 2. Put the stems in clean water. (Local lore recommends tepid water temperature.). Use a glass vase. Do not use a zinc pail. Check water level regularly.
- 3. Avoid drafts or bright sunlight.
 For prolonged bloom, place in cool spot at night.
